## WE KEEP GOING

Dear brothers in Christ, it is always a pleasure to greet you and I wish that the grace of GOD be in each one of you.

We never get tired of being grateful that during all these years they have supported us in the missionary work in Honduras.

As a family, we continue to work on planting churches in the Lenca zone, bringing hope to those most in need, especially of the Gospel of Jesus.

In the first days of July, we received a support group for the planting of new churches in Carrizal and Cedros Opatoro, La Paz, visiting house by house for 5 days. Our strategy consisted of taking two fruit trees to plant in each house and while we sowed, we shared the gospel of Christ. It was a wonderful experience; they were able to experience the love of God. We also helped with the repair of zinc floors and roofs in the houses. We had people converted to Christ among children and adults.

We also had the recognition and appointment of 5 pastors in the Comayagua area with our brother and Leader of the area Fredy Vega. Men committed to evangelization and the fulfillment of the redeeming work of Christ, to work in Cane, Monte Cristo, El Ciruelo, Lejamaní and the city of La Paz.

We are working hard in the direction and support of the pastors of the 4 departments of Honduras. We visit and maintain fluid communication with each church planter and pastor under my direction and supervision. We take hand in hand the Biblical formation for the preparation of leaders and

Pastors, attending the Bible Institute on weekends, and working with a total of 42 students.

The development of two sewing workshops for Lenca women, in different areas, is also being supported as a means of generating economic income to support their families. But it also has the purpose of reaching women who do not know Jesus. The sewing course ended in Yamaranguila with 9 women who will be organizing to form a Lencas product company; the other project began this July in the La Paz sector.





I also want to inform you that as a family we are doing well. Encouraged to continue working, Olga is helping with the classes at the Biblical Institute, preparing the Bible school for work with the children and the ministry with the women. The twins, Esther and Sarahy, and Izamar continue their studies, learning more English every day and they support us in communication. The twins were celebrating their 15th birthday; thanks to God's provision and the support of special people we were able to celebrate with close friends and relatives. Another thing we prayed for many years was for the opportunity for

the twins to travel to the United States to have an experience in all aspects. Thanks to the support of friends and family they were able to go, meet, and experience being in that beautiful country. We thank God for this wonderful opportunity.

We are reaping many successes, but as in everything we are also experiencing tests and needs for which we ask you to support us with your prayers and in the way you consider doing it too: **1.** We are asking the Lord for our support because it has dropped considerably; we need to pay for the girls' school and fuel costs to move around and do our job better.

**2.** We are praying to the Lord for the funds to finish paying off the cost of the vehicle that we have acquired and that has become an essential tool in our work.

**3.** We need the funds to equip a set of new wheels for the vehicle, which is ready to move in these difficult mountain roads. \$700.00



**4.** In general, pray for the different projects, pastors and for the advancement of the gospel to other places. We need laborers for his harvest.
