I hope you enjoyed your Reformation Day weekend! (Oct. 31st is Reformation Day, commemorating the day Martin Luther nailed the 95 theses on the Wittenburg church door, which is considered the spark that ignited the Protestant Reformation.)

We have 2 special prayer requests related to Berean Christian Academy:

1. One of our teachers, Ashley St. John, went home last Thurs. not feeling well. She ended up in the hospital later that evening, and is still in the hospital. The doctors have her on a special diet. They think it is something to do with her spleen or her appendix. She had had a liver transplant (in Chicago) as a toddler, but I don't know if there is any connection to that. She will be out for an indefinite amount of time, and we are hoping that surgery will not be necessary.

2. One of our first grader's mother, who is a police officer, was stabbed several times in town last Friday, and is in critical condition in the hospital. There is a whole back story of what had happened to cause the man to stab a police officer, but he basically just lost it because of a high level of frustration and feeling that his family was not going to get any justice for a wrongful shooting by the police. Our parent apparently was just in the wrong place at the wrong time to be the target of this attack. (The man was shot and killed by the police after the attack.)

Our first grader's name is Kian. He had really not seen his mother for a week before the incident, because she had been working night shifts, and was about to come home on Friday when she was attacked. (Kian stays with an aunt and grandmother when his mother has this work schedule.)

Thank you for your intercession for these hurting people.
