We kept seeing family after family, people we know and trained at EBI Jackson, heading to Papua New Guinea to finally launch their ministries. During a worldwide pandemic, the Lord continues to send people to the far corners of the world to share the Good News of Jesus Christ! How exciting and encouraging to see God is still at work even when our world seems upsidedown.

Classes here at EBI-Waukesha are being taught live and in-person. Covid is

still a concern and poses challenges but seems to be under control. We thank the Lord that we can continue training future missionaries while this pandemic continues to impact this world. Todd is getting good interaction with students as he teaches two electives every weekday at 1 p.m. Sue is sitting in, mostly for interaction with the students.



One of Todd's responsibilities is to secure enough housing to meet our staff needs at EBI. We still have three more families transitioning from Jackson this summer in addition to some new families joining our staff at EBI. So far "we" have put bids on two homes which were accepted!

Sue is on the Ladies Ministry Team comprised of three other staff ladies who will begin meeting with every staff lady to see how they are doing. This will be 17 meetings in the coming months - a great chance to get to know some of the Waukesha ladies.



Our home sits on a corner lot, so sun is unobstructed and pours into the windows, which is so cheery. That also gives us a long stretch of sidewalk, so we're thankful we kept our snow blower. It's currently extremely cold here, and there's lots and lots of snow piled up.

We are getting to know our way around Waukesha pretty well now. Again, when it warms up, we look forward to getting to know our neighbors and exploring beautiful Wisconsin.
