


Also thank you for each of the offerings you have sent, they have been very useful and of great support.

In the month of January, the leaders of each Lenca community in which we work met in hope to start planning activities for 2022 and also with the purpose of praying together. It was a very blessed time.



DONATION OF SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Every year in the month of December we collect a special offering to help some families

with school supplies for their children. Especially the children of the pastors

Classes in schools resumed in February. So we had the opportunity to donate school supplies to several children. In total we have been able to help 120 children, with the donation of funds from several brothers in Christ.
