# BIBLICALINSTITUTE FINISHES ITS FIRST SEMESTER

I am directly in charge of the Opalaca region in the northern part of the Lenca territory. I had 23 students of which 22 completed their classes.



It is a great satisfaction to be with them and see their growth in the knowledge of the Word of God and share it in new churches.

There are five churches in this region. The population there is of 40,000 people.



### WORKING WITH WOMEN

Yoamy has been visiting the women of each region together with her team of women leaders to encourage them.

They have a time of biblical teaching, of prayer, and fellowship together. Cheering each other on. They also share food with a needy family from each place.

## **DISTRIBUTION OF BIBLES**

We continue with the distribution of Bibles and helping to facilitate access to materials such as dictionaries and study Bibles. In the short season of coffee, it is an excellent time here to buy a bible since there are more funds in the families.

## CONSTRUCTION WORK IN THE CAMP KITCHEN

This month of April we were working on laying the floor of the dining room and kitchen of the camp in Yamaranguila. It was a great blessing to work together and achieve the goal.









## DISTRIBUTION OF FERTILIZERS TO SOME FAMILIES

The rainy season begins in May and with the help of the Terranova Church in Texas, we distributed 20 bags of fertilizer to some Lenca families. This fertilizer will be very helpful as they will be able to secure corn and beans for their homes.
