She is mature, pleasant, and understands that the Christian school is a ministry in the service of Jesus Christ. Should she give us a positive answer, I would continue for a time as school administrator. (I told someone that they will actually need 3 people to replace me as I've also been doing a lot of teaching.)

We would also like to be able to spend more time with our grandchildren, who live in Atlanta. We have only been able to spend about 1 week with them each year. They will soon be 10 and 8.
