Lenca women's ministry continues to advance.

Yoamy and her team are passionate about the work of Lenca women through discipleship and accompanying visits, where they have very varied activities. It is interesting to see how women walk long distances from their communities, some three hours, to receive their Bible study, fellowship and pray together.

Among women, we have another program: teaching sewing. We are taking to different villages at every three months end and we start in another community.





Development of new churches in the opalaca region.

In the mountains of Opalaca, we have a beautiful work of planting new churches. At this moment there are three places that are in the process of growth and development. Yes, with some struggles and trials, but it is beautiful to see new believers worship God and open their Bibles and listen to their testimonies of faith.
