Austrian Students

The end of the university semester is right around the corner for Austrian students. Most schools finish their classes either at the end of June or within the first two weeks of July. This is also when the formally scheduled campus ministry small groups will wrap up. However, students may spontaneously meet up throughout the summer.

Most students will return to their hometowns or home countries. They may not have a church back home. Please pray for these students, especially for the new believers.

Towards the end of the semester, the universities in Vienna had some evangelistic events at coffee stands. Their most recent, and last, was on June 18. One student, Niklas, has been described as a "classical seeker;" he knows a lot but is not yet convinced. However, he has been staying in contact with members of the campus ministry. Please pray for Niklas: that he would continue to ask questions and seek answers and that God would give him an open heart.
