Whereas the immediate short-term relief efforts for Carriacou have been strong, there will be a long-term rebuilding effort that will take some time. United Ministries Fellowship has agreed to set up an account for those who would like to contribute towards this. Donors will receive a tax-deductible receipt. We would have access to the funds and can direct them to specific individuals, or to the Evangelical Church of Carriacou in Hillsborough (a sister church). (Hillsborough is the main town of the island. Carriacou is only 12-13 square miles with a population of about 7000.)
