Good morning,

Beryl is officially a hurricane now, and expected to intensify before reaching the islands. It should be a category 3, and could become a category 4. The eye is projected to pass north of us (St. Vincent & the Grenadines), but this storm is big enough that we could still get hurricane force winds in the south of Grenada (where we are).

3 things are very unusual about this storm:

- 1. It is very early in the season.
- 2. It is following a path further south than most hurricanes.
- 3. It has become very big and strong, which is also unusual for this early in the season.

We are told that unusually warm ocean water is feeding it.

Our son, Stephen, is visiting us this week, so he will be experiencing this with us. He is scheduled to leave on Friday.
