2024 Ministry

- *Good News Club* ministry – 17clubs (12 public schools, 1 release-time school, 4 regular GNCs), 528 children reached with 57 professions of faith.
- *5-Day Club*® ministry – 10 clubs reaching 258 children with 2 professions of faith.
- Jackson County Fair – 824 children reached with 33 professions of faith.
- Festivals – 6 outreaches with 732 children reached with 10 professions of faith.
- Special Party Clubs – 19 reaching 320 children with 11 professions of faith.
- Literature Distribution of tracts and Meet the King Booklets –2 times reaching 700 children.

Eternal Results

CEF Jackson has a strong presence at the Jackson County fair and Civil War Muster. Children are invited into the tent to hear a brief presentation of the Gospel using *The Wordless Book*. Those that receive Christ are given Bibles and devotional books to assist them to grow spiritually. The fair and CW Muster are our largest outreach events by far. Many adults tell us that when they were young they heard the Gospel at the tent and now want their children to hear it too. Many tell us the difference God made in their lives. One 13-year-old girl came into the tent at the fair and shared how she had come last year and received Jesus as her Savior in the tent. She now attends church, goes to youth group, and has brought two of her friends to church and they have gotten saved, and all three have been baptized.

We are always looking for prayer warriors, greeters, and witnessing volunteers.
